Useful Information & Definitions

Your boat

The hull, superstructure, fittings, machinery, engines, gear and equipment that would normally be sold with the boat.

Personal effects

Are deemed to be items of a personal nature that would be removed on sale of the vessel. Examples might include clothing, books, charts and hand-held navigation equipment etc.

Insured value

The craft should be insured for its current market value i.e. the cost of replacing the vessel and equipment with a craft of similar age, type and condition. In the case of a craft recently purchased, an indication of current market value is normally the price paid plus the cost of any additional items.

Dinghies and tenders

Dinghies and tenders are not covered unless they are permanently marked with the name of the parent vessel.

Outboard motor lock

A lock that is designed to prevent the outboard motor being removed from the transom of a boat.

Wheel clamp

A device that is designed to prevent a wheel being turned or removed.

In commission

When your boat is fitted out and ready for immediate use.

Racing cover

If your intention is to race the vessel this will need to be declared when terms are requested.

Persons using the vessel

The insurance allows anyone to use the vessel with your permission, provided they have suitable experience.

Laid up

When your boat is stored in a safe berth, not fitted out and not ready for immediate use and is not used for any purpose other than fitting out or normal overhauling.

Duty of care

You have taken all reasonable steps to maintain and keep your boat and its gear and equipment in a proper state of repair and seaworthiness. You have taken all reasonable steps to protect your insured property from loss or damage.

Change in circumstances

You must contact us as soon as possible about any changes which may effect your insurance. In particular, you must tell us if you change your address, change your boat, or buy extra gear or equipment.

Claims

Telling us about a claim

If you have an accident or loss, you must contact us as soon as possible.

What you should or should not do

You must not admit responsibility unless underwriters have given you permission. You must let us have all correspondence with regards to the claim.
